What have we been up to this year?

Austin17House is going into its sixth year as an organization, and experienced tremendous growth and acceleration in a very small time frame. Our Executive Director came on full time in September of 2021 and spent the first few months creating and implementing structure, building capacity and assessing strengths, weaknesses and gaps. Here is a summary and highlights of the 2022 year below:



Our goal for 2022 was to raise \$250,000 to expand our reach and better impact our communities. This goal was achieved through generous donations, events, fundraisers, and grants.



Our hours of operation **tripled THIS YEAR** FROM 6 to 18 hours a week + 10 additional programs in Creative Arts, Wellness, Recreation + Life Skills!



Over **50%** of our volunteers have been volunteering diligently for over 3 years at the center + are dedicated to the work that they do, **and accrued over 5000 volunteer hours this year.**

College and Trade Exploration Series Launch

In partnership with a local community member, A17H developed and launched a seven-week series where high school students and young adult could partner with a college and trade exploration mentor to learn and apply the tools and resources needed to pursue their career path of choice while also receiving the necessary financial support to follow these dreams.

June 2022



Establishment of Fight Club 17

Fight Club 17 was a program born through a partnership with our friends at Chucky's Fight. This partnership allowed us to expand our reach in supporting our youth being affected by the impact of addiction, homelessness and suicidal ideation.

This peer support group has been a safe haven for **over 10 youth this past year**. Youth have also be referred through our Juvenile Court Diversion Program in partnership with the NH Juvenile Court Diversion Network.
